

## FORESTS 2019: GENERAL SCORING METHODOLOGY CATEGORY WEIGHTINGS

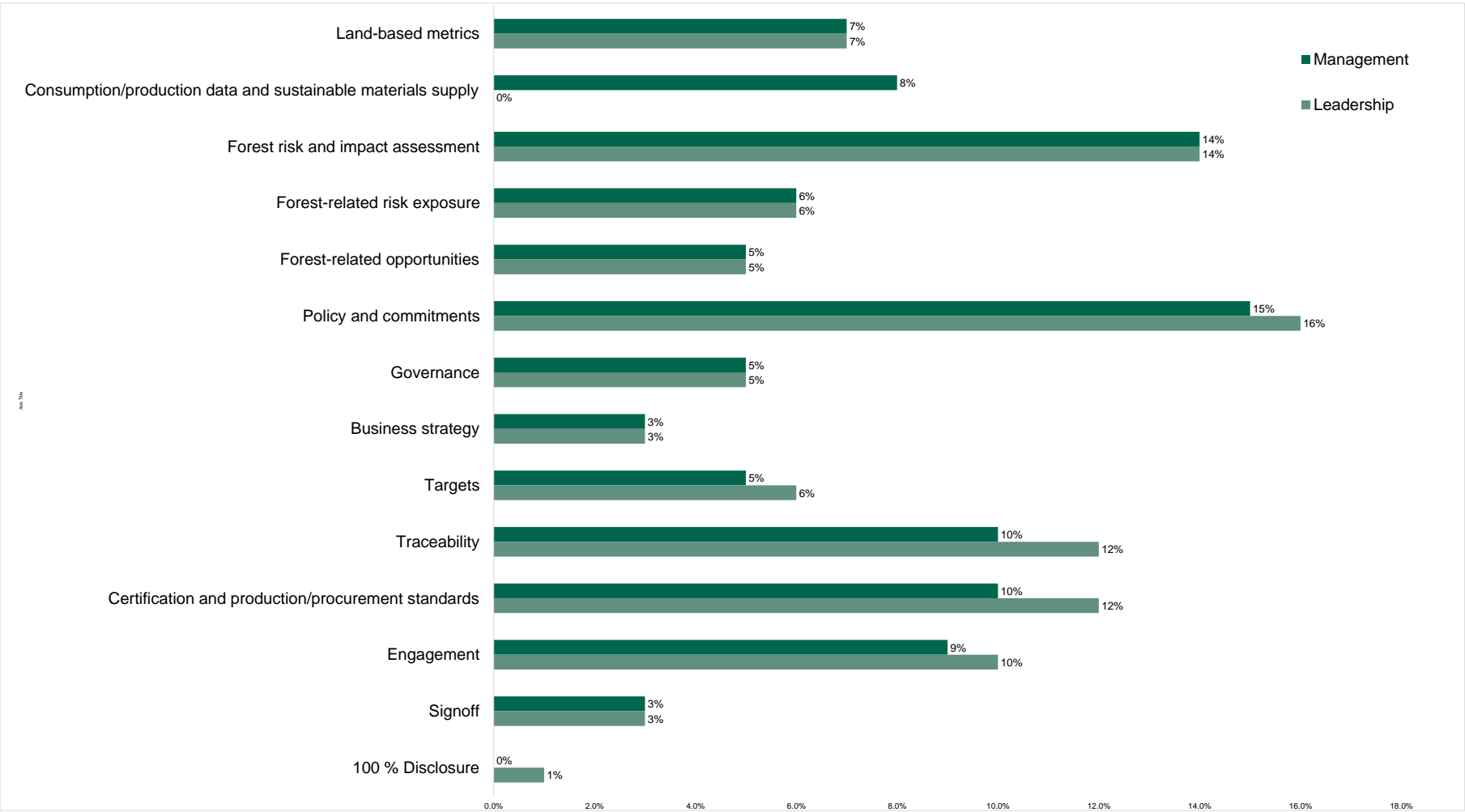
### Scoring categories & weightings: an overview

Scoring categories are groupings of questions by topic. They are different groups of the 2019 questionnaire modules. They may consist of a collection of modules, a section of a module or may be equal to a module. Questions are grouped in particular scoring categories according to their theme and importance. Each scoring category has a particular weighting that represents the percentage of the final score at Management and Leadership that will be dependent on that category. Weightings are applied only to scoring categories at Management and Leadership levels and they reflect the relative importance of each category in an organizations' progression towards environmental stewardship, within the boundaries of the CDP questionnaire and the available scoring criteria. This year, weightings will not vary between the General questionnaire and the Paper & forestry sector questionnaire. However, this is likely to change in the future when new sectors are introduced and when the Paper & forestry sector is further developed.

### 2019 Scoring Categories

The 14 scoring categories in 2019 are: Land-based metrics, Consumption/production data and sustainable materials supply, Forest risk and impact assessment, Forest-related risk exposure, Forest-related opportunities, Policy and commitments, Governance, Business strategy, Targets, Traceability, Certification and production/procurement standards, Engagement, Sign Off, and 100% Disclosure.

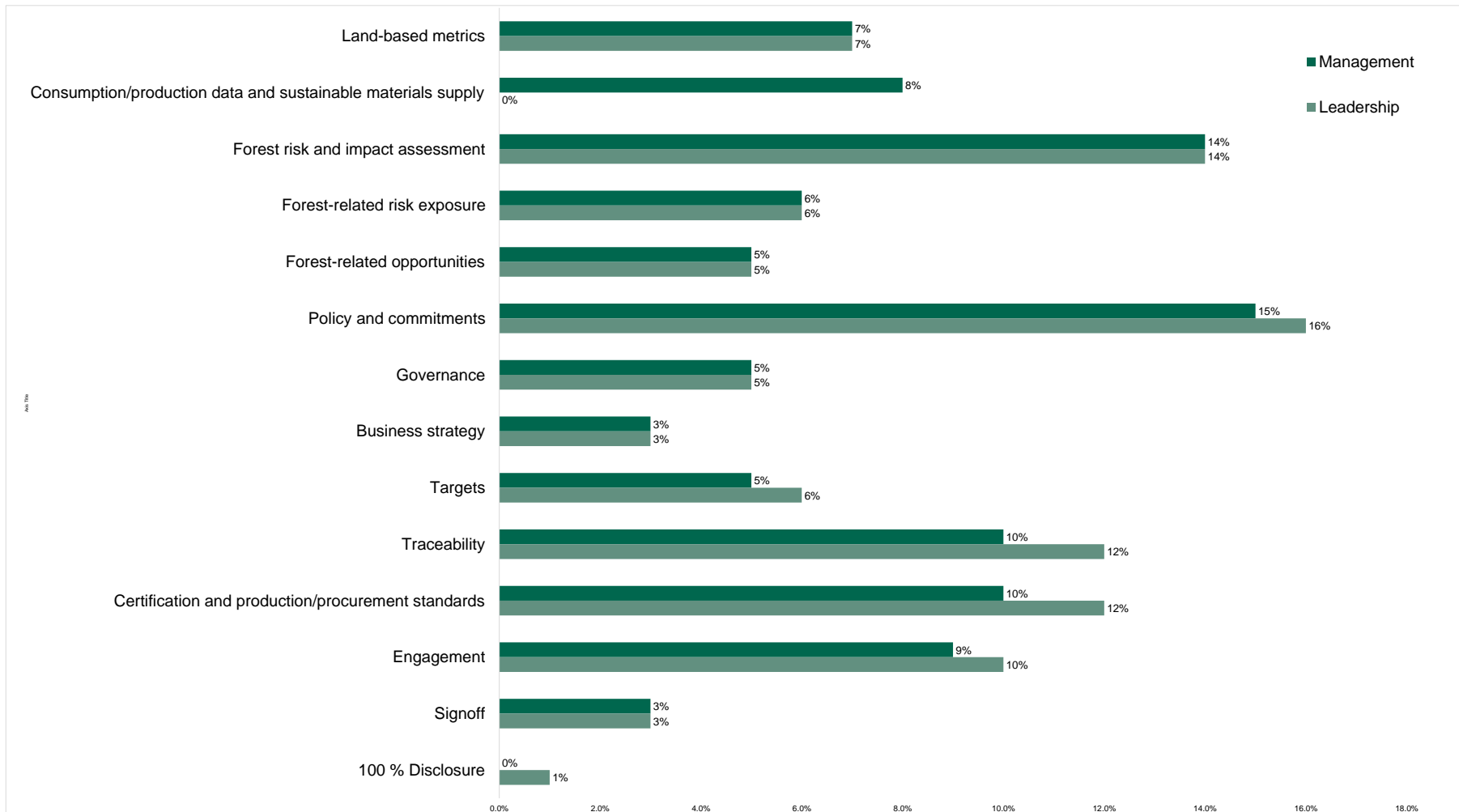
